## Pro Loco Art Competition 2017

### Rules of Entry

- The competition closes on **Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> August 2017**.
- Entrants must register on the Matlock Bath Parish Council website or by contacting the Parish Clerk.
- Entrants must provide their own art materials/paper/canvass.
- Artwork is limited to a maximum of A2 size.
- Artwork can include drawing and painting, graphics, collage, 2D, Textiles, 3D and digital art etc.
- The finished picture must be based on a scene or artefact from within the Matlock Bath Parish.
- A short paragraph must be submitted with the work about how the work has been achieved. This should include the type of materials used. For digital art, the process should be outlined.
- A digital photograph should be sent to [clerk@matlockbathparishcouncil.gov.uk](mailto:clerk@matlockbathparishcouncil.gov.uk) of the work to be used on the Parish Council website.
- No more than one prize per entrant.
- Maximum of *two* entries from each participant.
- Entrants are responsible for 'dropping off work' no later than Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2017.
- In the event of a dispute, the Chairman's decision is final.
- A short-list of finalists will be drawn up after the closing date.
- ***The winning work of the Adult first prize will remain with the Parish Council and be part of the permanent display of the winners from previous years.***
- By entering the competition entrants are giving permission to Matlock Bath Parish Council to use the finished image on any publicity material and/or exhibit as appropriate. \*\*\*

**\*\*\*Please note: By entering artwork in to the Pro Loco Art Competition the originator is granting us a royalty-free, non-exclusive licence to publish and use the image on any of the Parish Council's materials, website or by our sponsors. It is important to note, however, that artists still own the copyright to the artwork they enter into the competition and if their image is selected for use, we will endeavour to publish their name alongside it on the materials or website. The Parish Council cannot guarantee that all images will be used.**

### Other Information

- All shortlisted work will be displayed on **Saturday 16<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> September 2017** where members of the public will vote for their favourites.
- A presentation ceremony will be held (details to be confirmed nearer the time).
- Classes of prizes –
  - Adult (aged 17 and over) – 1<sup>st</sup> Prize - £150, 2<sup>nd</sup> Prize - £100, 3<sup>rd</sup> Prize - £50
  - Best Villager - £50
  - Parish Council Award - £50
  - Most artistic, innovative design - £50£50
  - Highly Commended - £25
  - Junior Artist (Aged 4-7) – All prizes given in the form of gift vouchers
  - Junior Artist (Aged 8-11) – All prizes given in the form of gift vouchers
  - Young Artist (Aged 12-16) – All prizes given in the form of gift vouchers
- **Voting** – Votes can only be cast in person on the days of display. One voting form per person. No proxy votes are allowed.
